SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS


- This product is designed for household use only.
- This product is not for commercial use.
- This product is not for use along with external timers or separate remote-control systems.
- This product is not for outdoor use.
- Close supervision is necessary when the product is used by or near children. To ensure your children's safety, please keep all packaging materials (e.g., plastic bags, boxes, polystyrene) out of their reach.
- This product is not to be used by persons with reduced physical, sensory, mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they are supervised by a person responsible for their safety.
- Do not leave the product unattended when in use.
- Do not touch hot surfaces while using the product to prevent the risk of injury or burns.
- To avoid any risk of electrical hazards, do not immerse the cord, plug, or the product itself in water or other liquids.

GETTING STARTED

- 1. Use the lid handle to open the product.
- 2. Use a pastry brush, dip lightly with cooking oil, and brush it lightly on both top and bottom plates or spread it using an absorbent kitchen towel and wipe off any excess cooking oil.
- 3. Prepare the mini donut batters.

NOTE: When used for the first time, the product may emit slight smoke or odor, and it is normal will disappear after 1 or 2 uses, and it does not affect the product's safety. However, the flavor of the first mini donuts prepared may affect its flavor. It is recommended that the first mini donuts prepared must be discarded.

HOW TO USE

- 1. Insert the plug into the power outlet. Both the Power Light and Preheat Light will turn on as the product begins preheating.
- 2. After approximately 3 minutes, the Preheat Light will turn off, which indicates that the unit is preheated and ready for use.
- 3. Fill the batter into the mini donut mold. Do not overfill since the batter will expand when baked.
- 4. Close the lid, and let the mini donuts bake for about 5 minutes.

NOTE: The Preheat Light will turn on and off during use, as the unit maintains the ideal cooking temperature, which prevents overheating.

- 5. To check the mini donut if it is perfectly cooked, insert a dry toothpick into the mini donut. If it comes out dry, then the mini donuts are ready. If necessary, close the lid and continue baking for at least 30 seconds until the mini donuts are golden brown in color and based on your preference.
- 6. Gently remove the baked mini donuts by using plastic or wood utensils.
- 7. Unplug the product from the power outlet and allow it to cool before cleaning.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

- Unplug the product from the power outlet and allow it to cool before cleaning. Never immerse the product in water or any other liquid.
- Wipe the lid, base, and cooking plates with a damp cloth and a non-abrasive soap or dishwashing liquid.
- When done, wipe the product with a clean, soft, damp cloth and let it dry.
- Store the product in a clean, cool, and dry place.
- Never store the product while it is still hot or still plugged in.
- Never wrap the cord tightly around the product. Do not put any stress on cord where it enters inside the product, as this could cause breakage.
- Regularly check the product for damage. If you see damage on the appliance or the power cord, discontinue use and contact ConcepStore After Sales team.
- Do not repair the product by yourself. To avoid hazards, contact Concep-Store After Sales team. for repair/replacement.


