# Caution

Never plug a power cord showing any sign of damage along its length or on both ends. If in doubt, call our customer care hotlines or consult your trusted appliance dealer.



Properly ground your refrigerator while avoiding telephone, electric and/or gas lines. Unplug your refrigerator from the wall outlet before cleaning or performing maintenance work.



Keep all packing materials away from children. Plastic polybags may be used as packaging to protect your refrigerator during transport. Recycle whenever possible.



Use your refrigerator only for keeping food and beverage items in a normal household or similar setting. It is not designed for storing volatile, flammable objects and/or substances. Never attempt to disassemble, repair and/or modify the system for use in a specialised purpose aside from its intended function.



At the end of its useful life, ask your local authorities about the proper disposal procedure for your refrigerator.

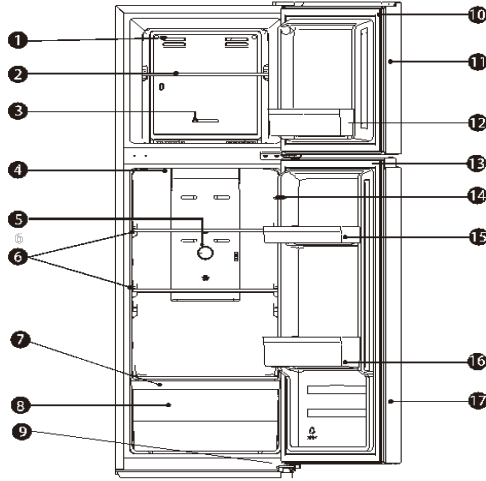

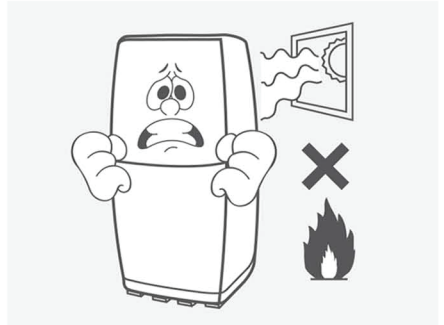

# Start Up

Quick and easy steps to get your refrigerator ready.

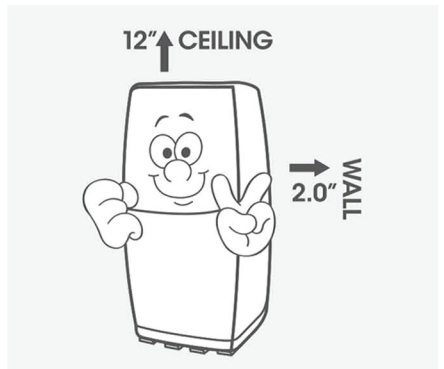
Place refrigerator on a firm & flat surface, away from direct sunlight & heat sources (like an oven or stove).



**CAUTION or WARNING:**

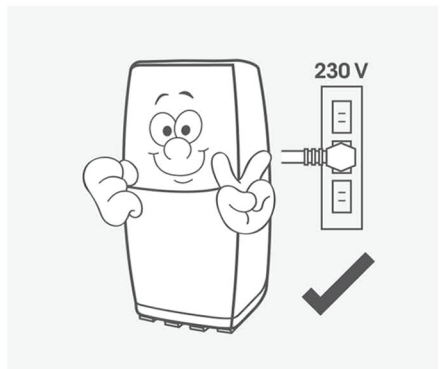
Install the unit in a well ventilated location.

Leave at least two inches of space between ref and wall, and 12 inches of space between ref and ceiling or overhead cabinet.



Let the motor oil settle down for three to four hours before plugging your Refrigerator.

Plug your refrigerator directly to a 230V wall outlet. Avoid using extension cord.



Set both control knob to NORMAL. Allow your refrigerator to cool for four (4) hours before loading food and beverage items.

Adjust the temperature to the appropriate setting for efficient cooling performance. See temperature control section for more information.

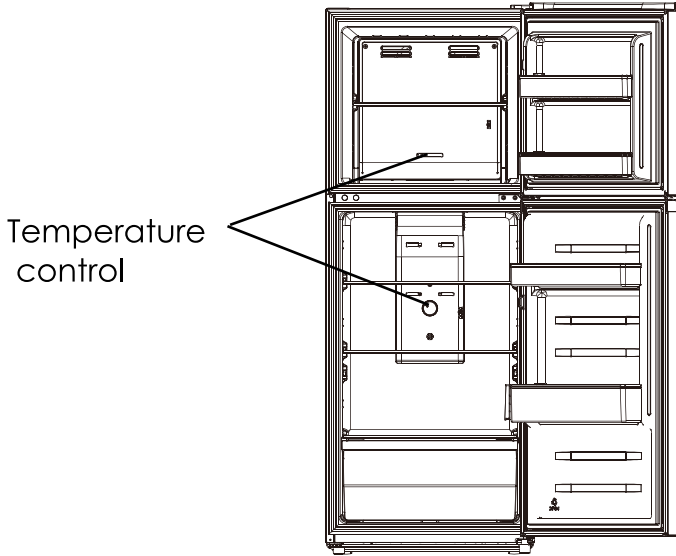

## Temperature control

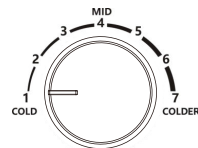
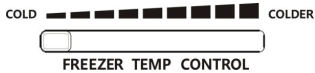
Maximize refrigerator performance and energy efficiency.

Your **Condura NO FROST Inverter Refrigerator** has two control knobs. Adjusting the temperature control setting in the refrigerator compartment affects the temperature in both the freezer and refrigerator section.



Freezer Temperature Control










Refrigerator Temperature Control



### Importante Note:

For stable cooling performance, set the control knob to MID for freezer and ref section.

Proper temperature management is essential for the optimal performance of your refrigerator. It is recommended to adjust the temperature based on the amount of food and beverage items stored in your refrigerator:

Be mindful not to obstruct the air vents found at the rear of the freezer and fridge compartments to ensure free air circulation. Adequate spacing of stored food and beverage items will also ensure the circulation of cool air.

**Defrosting**

Do not use mechanical devices or other means to accelerate the defrosting process.



# Care and Maintenance

Simple ways to make your ref last (almost) a lifetime.

## REFRIGERATOR CLEANING

Proper use of your No Frost Refrigerator Inverter ensures that it functions at an optimal level. Regularly cleaning your refrigerator will keep it in top working condition.

UNPLUG your Condura NoFrost Inverter Refrigerator. Remove all contents, including racks and shelves.

CLEAN the racks, shelves, gasket, interior and exterior of your refrigerator using a clean damp cloth. Wipe it dry.

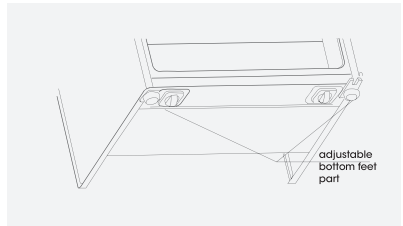
PLUG your refrigerator directly to a 230V wall outlet. Set the control knob to NORMAL and allow your refrigerator to cool for four(4) hours before loading food and beverage items.

WARNING – Do not use electrical appliances inside the food storage compartments of the appliance, unless they are of the type recommended by the manufacturer □(IEC 60335-2-24)



## USING THE LEVELLERS

It is important to keep your refrigerator standing firm on a level surface to eliminate vibration and unnecessary noises during operation. Adjust the levellers found in both sides of your refrigerator to ensure its stability.

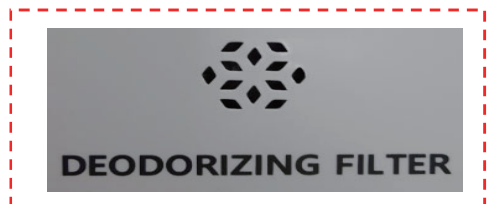


## LED LIGHT REPLACEMENT

It is recommended to have our service technicians to do the light replacement. Call our customer care hotlines for further assistance.

## DEODORIZER

This is to prevent unpleasant odour build-up in your refrigerator.

## Safety Information

Important instructions for your safety and protection.

Call our customer care hotline or any authorised service center immediately for repair or replacement of exposed or damaged power cord.

When touching or cleaning the plug, make sure your hands are dry.

When unplugging, always grip the plug firmly and do not yank the power cord out of the wall socket.

Ensure that the power cord is not bent excessively or pressed down by a heavy object. Do not plug refrigerator in loose sockets.

The plug's tip should be cleaned regularly with a dry cloth; otherwise, it may cause fire.

DO NOT USE EXTENSION CORD

### USAGE & STORAGE

Use your refrigerator only for the storage of food and beverage items.

Storing hazardous materials such as ether and benzyne can cause an explosion.

Do not store store vaccines, heat-sensitive medicine and scientific materials etc. This may require precise temperature.

It is recommended that you only store bottled drinks in the refrigerator compartment.

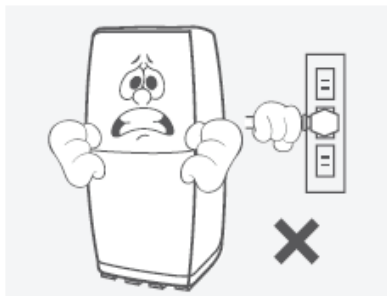
If not to be used for a long time, refrigerator should be unplugged. A possible problem in power cable may cause fire

### WARRANTY

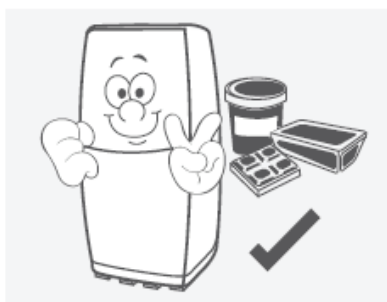
Only accredited service technicians are authorised to repair this product. If you suspect it is damaged, or if it malfunctions, please see the troubleshooting section. Do not attempt to disassemble, repair nor modify your refrigerator as this may render your warranty void.

### DISPOSAL

Recycle when possible. Contact your local authorities for the proper disposal of your refrigerator as it contains flammable gas that require special disposal procedures.

### USAGE & STORAGE

**WARNING: Your Inverter No Frost's cooling system contains R600a refrigerant.**

The gas is flammable. Therefore, pay attention to not damaging the cooling system and piping during usage and transportation. In the event of damage, keep your product away from potential fire sources that can cause the product catch a fire and ventilate the room in which the unit is places.

### CAUTION or WARNING :

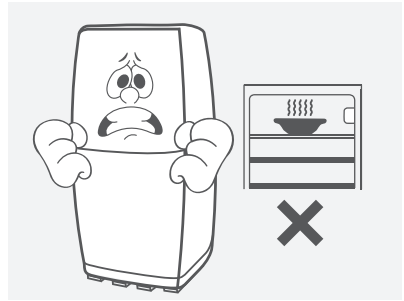
1. Donot let children and lack of experience and knowledge to play or operate the appliance.

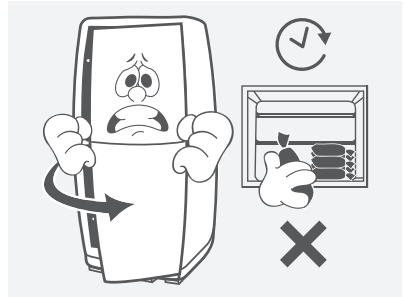
## Storing Fresh Food

Keep food fresh for your home.

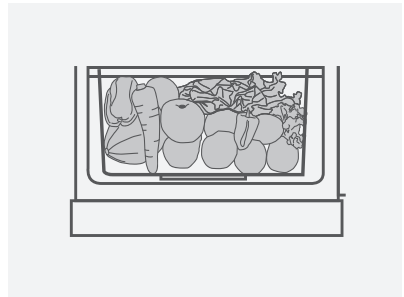
Allow warm food or hot beverages to cool down to room temperature before storing it in your refrigerator. Put frozen food and beverage items in the fridge compartments to thaw.



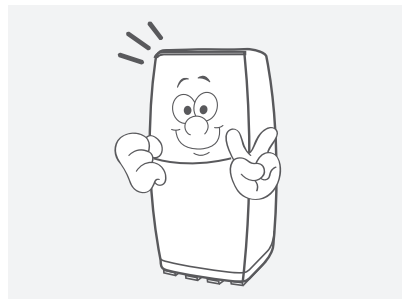
Do not keep the ref or freezer door open for too long when putting in or taking out food or beverage items.



Wash and rinse fruits and vegetables to prolong freshness. Dry before storing in the crisper pan.



A large amount or load of stored food and beverage items will lower the cooling efficiency of your refrigerator. On the other hand, minimizing unnecessary opening of doors will help the unit to function efficiently.

# Troubleshooting

Things to check before calling our customer service hotlines.

PROBLEM	CHECK IF
Refrigerator would not turn on or is not working at all.	Power plug is properly connected to a wall outlet. Refrigerator light turns on when the fridge door is left open.
Temperature is not cold enough or refrigerator is not cooling.	Refrigerator has adequate clearance from the wall. (Please see <b>start up</b> section for more information) Freezer and fridge doors are tightly shut. Air vents are not blocked. (Please see <b>storing fresh food</b> section for more information) Food and beverage items are spaced enough to allow adequate air circulation. (Please see <b>storing fresh food</b> section for more information) Temperature setting is properly adjusted according to refrigerator load. (Please see <b>temperature control</b> section for more information)
Refrigerator emits a foul odor.	There is no spoiled food or beverage item inside. Strong smelling food items are properly sealed. (Please see <b>storing fresh food</b> section for more information) There is no excessive accumulated defrost water in drain pan. (Please see <b>care and maintenance</b> section for more information) Refrigerator is thoroughly cleaned. (Please see <b>care and maintenance</b> section for more information)
There is sweating in the exterior ref cabinet, particularly during cold weather.	Temperature is properly set. (Please see <b>temperature control</b> section for more information) Freezer and fridge doors are tightly shut. Sweat looks like condensation on the window of an air-conditioned room on a rainy day. This is normal.
Refrigerator makes unusual noises.	Refrigerator is installed on a stable, level surface. (Please see <b>start up</b> section for more information) Note that noise may also come from normal operation: Refrigerant passing through the system may make sizzling sounds. Thermostat control turning on and off will make ticking sounds. Compressor will make a humming sound.

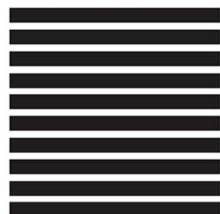

(CDI) warrants the purchaser that this **CONDURA NO FROST INVERTER REFRIGERATOR** will be free from defective material and workmanship and agrees to repair or, at its discretion, replace any defective material with a new or equivalent part through any of its Authorised Service Centers only if found to be manufacturer's defect and in accordance with the terms of this warranty, subject to the following conditions:

### 1. COVERAGE OF WARRANTY

The Condura No Frost Inverter Warranty is applied to Refrigerators used for household purposes only.

### 2. WARRANTY PERIOD (from the date of original purchase)

This warranty is not transferable, valid only in the Philippines, and does not apply to damage(s) due to fire, improper use or punctured, force majeure (typhoon, flood, lightning, earthquake, etc.), use with voltage beyond the allowable range of 198V to 242V, or failure to follow operating instructions provided in the manual.
