Before operating the refrigerator, please read the following information in the owner's manual thoroughly and keep it for your reference. Failure to observe these safety guidelines could result in fire, electric shock, injuries, or damage to your refrigerator and/or other properties.

CAUTION / WARNING:

-  This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
-  Do not use sharp objects or tools that may cause damage to the refrigerant circuit.
-  Do not use electrical appliances inside the food storage compartments of the appliance.
-  The LED Light must not be replaced by user! If the LED Light is damaged, it is highly recommended to have our authorized service personnel to do the replacement for you.
-  Do not use extension cord.
-  When positioning the appliance, ensure the supply cord is not trapped or damaged.
-  Do not locate multiple portable socket-outlets or portable power supplies at the rear of the appliance.
-  This appliance is intended for household use and similar applications such as:
 - staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments;
 - farm houses and by clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments.
 - bed and breakfast type environments;
 - catering and similar non-retail applications

SAFETY INFORMATION (DO's and DONT'S)

A) POWER/SUPPLY CORD

- 1) Plug the unit properly into a wall outlet with its required voltage.
- 2) Please ensure a minimum clearance of 2" (inch) for air ventilation and to prevent damage to the supply cord.
- 3) When touching or cleaning the plug, make sure your hands and rug are dry.
- 4) Do not plug the refrigerator into a loose socket. There will be a risk of electric shock or fire.

B) STORAGE AND HANDLING

- 1) Storing hazardous materials, such as ether and benzyne, can cause explosions.
- 2) DO NOT store bottled drinks in the freezer.
- 3) DO NOT touch the freezer's inner wall with wet hands to avoid frost bites.
- 4) Avoid water contact in areas near the temperature control knob to prevent shock hazards.

C) DISPOSAL

Please contact local authorities in regard to the safe disposal of this product. Ensure that none of the pipes on the back of the product are damaged prior to disposal.

WARNING:

The refrigerant of this No Frost Top Mount Inverter cooling system contains R600a refrigerant.

The gas is flammable. Therefore, pay attention to not damaging the cooling system and piping during usage and transportation. In the event of damage, keep your product away from potential fire sources that may cause fire.

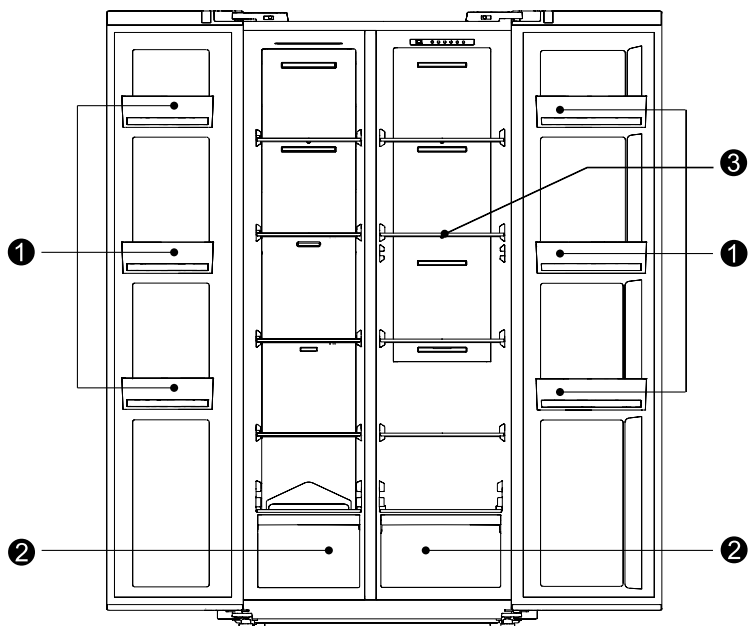
Instructions for replacement of supply cord:

START-UP OPERATION

Congratulations! and thank you for your purchase.

- Install the unit in a well-ventilated location.
- The start-up of the unit (compressor) will be after 3 minutes.
- Leave at least 2 inches of space between ref and wall and 12 inches of space between ref and ceiling or overhead cabinet.
- Upon delivery, let the motor oil settle down for 3-4 hours before plugging in the product.
- Plug the product directly to a wall outlet (220-240V) and set the temperature control knob to Setting No. 4.
- To compensate for floor unevenness, adjust clockwise or counterclockwise the leveler located on the lower front corners of your refrigerator. It is recommended that the unit be slightly tilted backward to allow defrosting water to flow inward during defrosting.
- For safety reasons, it is advisable to ground the unit by connecting the ground wire provided at the back of the unit.

CAUTION / WARNING:

- Place refrigerator on a firm and flat surface.
- Do not place the product near direct sunlight or heat sources.
- Do not use extension cord.

LEVELLING FEET

The refrigerator should stand firm to avoid vibration.

If required, adjust the leveling feet to compensate for the uneven floor.

The front should be slightly higher than the rear to aid in door closing.

Leveling feet can be turned easily by tipping the cabinet slightly.

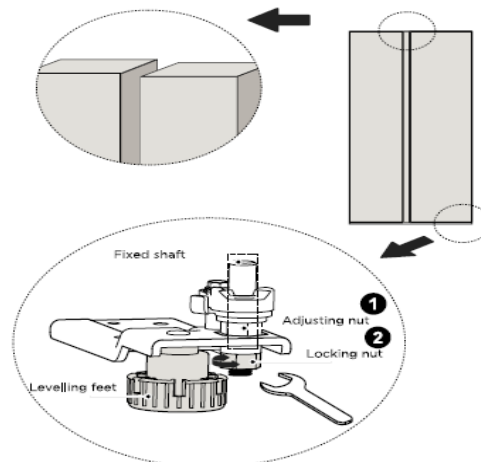
Turn the leveling feet counterclockwise to raise the unit, clockwise to lower it.

If the doors are not at the same height, the door can be adjusted with a spanner.

A. Loosen locking nut counterclockwise.

B. Rotate the adjusting nut counterclockwise to adjust the height of door.

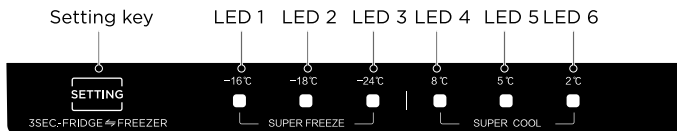
C. When the door is correctly aligned, tighten the locking nut clockwise.

Use and functions

Functions



ATTENTION

The actual control panel may differ from model to model.

Display


When the power is on for the first time, full display shall last for 3 seconds, then enter into the normal operation display; (When the power is on for the first time, the setting temperature of refrigerator and freezer is 5°C/-18°C respectively)


When there is a fault, the fault code is displayed; when there is no fault, the setting range of the refrigeration compartment is displayed.

The display screen is on when the refrigerator door is open while the display screen is off when the freezer door is closed;

Key operation

After each key operation of temperature adjustment, the corresponding set temperature flashes for 3S;

In the refrigeration temperature setting mode, long press the setting key “” for 3S to switch to the freezing temperature setting mode;

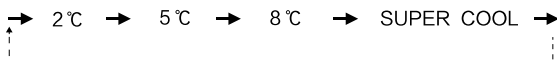
In the freezing temperature setting mode, long press the setting key for “” 3S to switch to the refrigeration temperature setting mode;

Locking and unlocking

The locking state shall be automatically entered after 30 seconds without key operation; No manual lock/unlock settings;

Temperature setting of refrigerating chamber

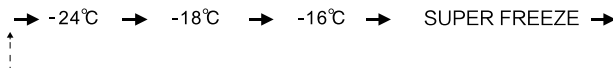
When setting the refrigerating temperature, the temperature will cycle in the following order each time the setting key is pressed. In the super cool state, LED4 and LED6 will light up at the same time. Super cool exists for 6h, as shown below:



Temperature setting of freezing chamber

When setting the freezer temperature, the temperature will cycle in the following order each time the setting key is pressed.

In the super freeze state, LED1 and LED3 will light up at the same time, super freeze exists for 24 h, as shown below:



Recommended setting: refrigerating chamber 5°C, freezing chamber - 18°C.

Opening warning and alarm control

When the door is opened, the corresponding chamber lamp are on. There is no door opening prompt tone and door opening alarm.

Fault indication

The following warnings appearing on the display indicate corresponding faults of the refrigerator. Though the refrigerator may still have cold storage function with the following faults, the user shall contact a maintenance specialist for maintenance, so as to ensure optimized operation of the appliance.

LED1, LED6 flash	Refrigerator temperature sensor fault
LED1, LED3 flash	Freezer temperature sensor fault
LED1, LED5 flash	Frozen defrosting sensor fault
LED1, LED4 flash	Ambient temperature fault

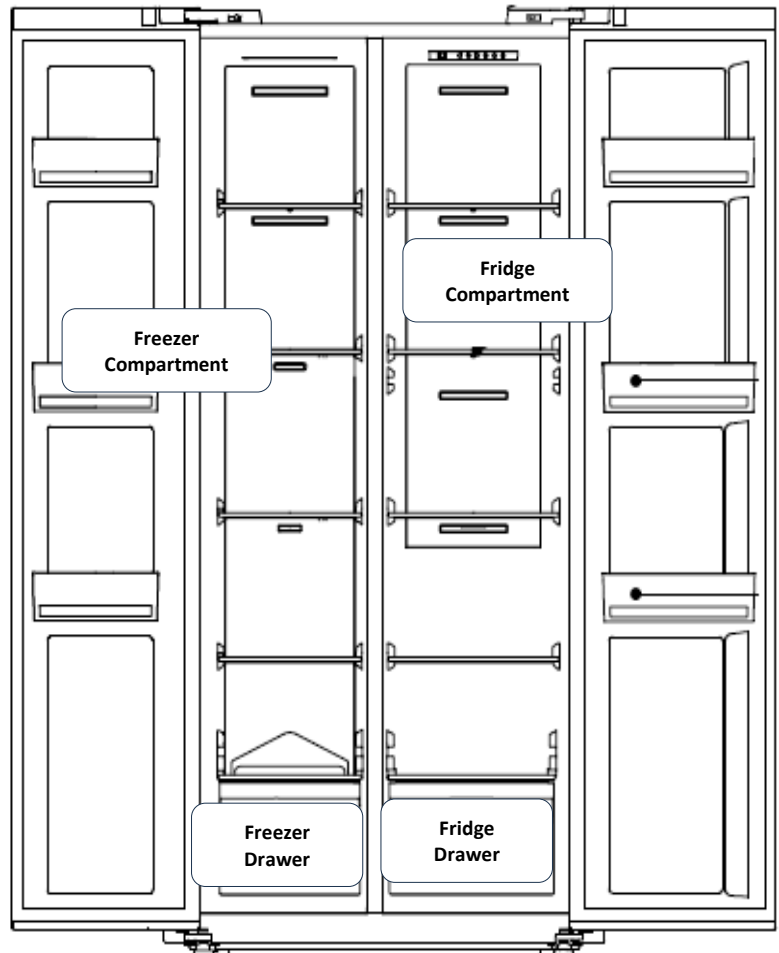
ATTENTION

The quick-freezing function is designed to maintain the nutritional value of the food in the freezer. It can freeze the food in the shortest time. If a large amount of food is frozen at one time, it is recommended that the user turn on the quick-freezing function and put the food in. At this time, the freezing speed of the freezer compartment is increased, which can quickly freeze the food, effectively lock the nutrition of the food, and facilitate storage.

FOOD STORAGE TIPS

Keeping Food Fresh:

- Allow warm food or hot beverages to cool down to room temperature before storing them in your refrigerator. Put frozen food and beverage items in the fridge compartments to thaw.
- Do not keep the fridge or freezer door open for too long when storing or taking out food or beverage items.
- Wash and rinse fruits and vegetables to prolong their freshness. Dry before storing in the crisper pan.
- It is recommended to put leftover and smelly foods in sealed containers to prevent from spreading unnecessary odor inside the compartment.
- It is recommended to minimize the frequency of the door opening when storing large amount of food and beverages to help maintain the optimum cooling performance.
- Store fruits and vegetables inside the crisper to preserve its freshness and avoid excess



DEFROSTING

The Condura No Frost Inverter Refrigerator is designed to automatically defrost completely. Defrosted water from the evaporator will collect in the drain pan, where the accumulated water evaporates with the help of auxiliary tube.

WARNING:

Do not use mechanical devices or other means to accelerate the defrosting process, other than those recommended by the manufacturer.

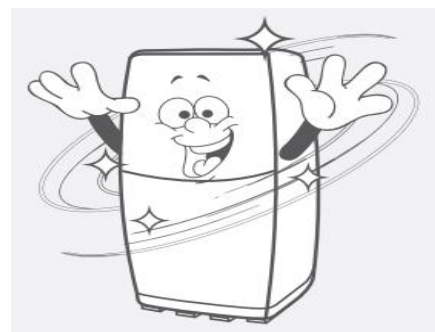
CLEANING, CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Simple ways to make your refrigerator last (almost) a lifetime.

REFRIGERATOR CLEANING

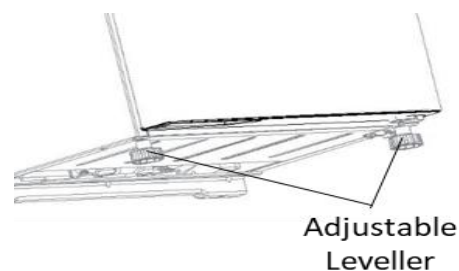
Proper use of the No Frost Refrigerator Inverter ensures that it functions at an optimal level. It is important to regularly clean your fridge, or at least give it a wipe down, because of the build-up of mold and spillage from various perishable items kept in the fridge.

- **UNPLUG** No frost refrigerator. Remove all contents, including racks and shelves.
- **CLEAN** the racks, shelves, gasket, interior, and exterior of the refrigerator using a clean, damp cloth. Wipe it dry.
- **PLUG** your refrigerator directly into a 230V wall outlet.
- **WIPE** inside and outside of the refrigerator until it is clean and dry.



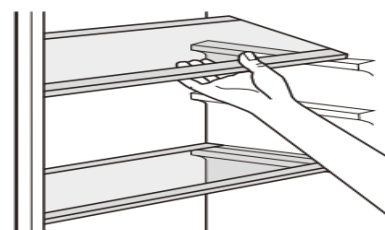
USING THE LEVELER

It is important to keep the refrigerator standing firm on a level surface to eliminate vibration and unnecessary noises during operation. Adjust the levelers found on both sides of the refrigerator to ensure its stability.



MOVABLE SHELVES

The walls of the refrigerator are equipped with a series of runners so that the shelves can be positioned as desired.



LED REPLACEMENT

It is recommended to have our authorized service personnel do the light replacement. Call our customer care hotlines for further assistance.




WARNING - Do not use electrical appliances inside the food storage compartments, unless they are of the type recommended by the manufacturer.

NOTICE:

Refrigerator's surface may become warm during operation - this is **NORMAL**. This indicates that the internal condenser tube is pumping heat around the cabinet to prevent condensation/sweating on the surface of the cabinet.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Things to check before calling our customer service hotlines.

 **Caution!** Before troubleshooting, disconnect the power supply. Only authorized service personnel must do the troubleshooting that is not in this manual.

PROBLEM	ACTION/S NEEDED
The refrigerator would not turn on or not working at all.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check that the power or supply cord is properly connected.• Check the main fuse and electrical system of the house.
The fridge and freezer are not cooling enough.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check that the freezer and fridge doors are tightly closed.• Check the storage of food and beverages; there must be enough space to allow air circulation.• Check that the control knob is at the proper setting based on the amount of load.• Check that the refrigerator is exposed directly to heat source.
The refrigerator cools too much	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure that there is no air vent blockage inside the freezer. Adjust the freezer damper if necessary and also, check if temperature was set properly based on the stored amount of load.
The refrigerator emits a foul odor	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check if there's no spoiled food or beverage inside the fridge.• Make sure that the strong-smelling food items are properly sealed.• There is no excessive accumulated defrost water in the drain pan.• The refrigerator is thoroughly cleaned.
The refrigerator makes unusual noises.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A refrigerator must be installed in a stable floor. Adjust the leveler.• Move the appliance slightly if it's possible to touch the wall or other objects. <p>Note that the noise may also come from the normal operation. Refrigerant passing through the system may cause sizzling sounds. On and Off Thermostat control operation may cause ticking sounds. The compressor can make a humming sound.</p>

- Cool down hot food items first before placing them inside the refrigerator. It will increase the interior temperature, which may affect the freshness of the food while being stored inside the refrigerator.
- DO NOT keep the fridge and freezer doors open for too long to prevent hot air from entering to reduce the amount of wasted electricity.
- DO NOT block the cold air outlet with food items when the cold air does not spread into every corner of the compartments. It will result to a higher electricity consumption.
- Temperature must be set properly according to the amount of food and beverages.
- Defrost and clean refrigerator regularly.

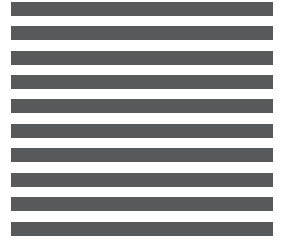
