Safety information

Please observe the following safety precautions in order to use safely and correctly the refrigerator and to prevent accident and danger during repair.

1. Be care of an electric shock. Disconnect power cord from wall outlet and wait for more than three minutes before replacing PCB parts. Shut off the power whenever replacing and repairing electric components.
2. When connecting power cord, please wait for more than five minutes after power cord was disconnected from the wall outlet.
3. Please check if the power plug is pressed down by the refrigerator against the wall. If the power plug was damaged, it may cause fire or electric shock.
4. If the wall outlet is over loaded, it may cause fire. Please use its own individual electrical outlet for the refrigerator.
5. Please make sure the outlet is properly earthed, particularly in wet or damp area.
6. Use standard electrical components when replacing them.
7. Make sure the hook is correctly engaged. Remove dust and foreign materials from the housing and connecting parts.
8. Do not fray, damage, machine, heavily bend, pull out or twist the power cord.
9. Please check the evidence of moisture intrusion in the electrical components. Replace the parts or mask it with insulation tapes if moisture intrusion was confirmed.
10. Do not let the customers repair, disassemble and reconstruct the refrigerator for themselves. It may cause accident, electric shock, or fire.
11. Do not store flammable materials such as ether, benzene, alcohol, chemicals, gas, or medicine in the refrigerator.
12. Do not put flower vase, cup, cosmetics, chemicals, etc., or container with full of water on the top of the refrigerator.
13. Do not put glass bottles with full of water into the freezer. The contents shall freeze and break the glass bottles.
14. When you scrap the refrigerator, please disconnect the door gasket first and scrap it.

Safety information

General safety

-  **WARNING!** Keep ventilation openings, in the appliance enclosure or in the built-in structure, clear of obstruction.
-  **WARNING!** Do not use mechanical devices or other means to accelerate the defrosting process, other than those recommended by the manufacturer.
-  **WARNING!** Do not damage the refrigerant circuit.
-  **WARNING!** Do not use extension cord.
-  **WARNING!** Do not use other electrical appliances (such as ice cream makers) inside of refrigerating appliances, unless they are approved for this purpose by the manufacture.
-  **WARNING!** Do not touch the light bulb if it has been on for a long period of time because it could be very hot.¹⁾
- Do not store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with a flammable propellant in this appliance.
- The refrigerant isobutane (R600a) is contained within the refrigerant circuit of the appliance, a natural gas with a high level of environmental compatibility, which is nevertheless flammable.
- During transportation and installation of the appliance, be certain that none of the components of the refrigerant circuit become damaged.
 - avoid open flames and sources of ignition
 - thoroughly ventilate the room in which the appliance is situated
- It is dangerous to alter the specifications or modify this product in any way. Any damage to the cord may cause a short circuit, fire and/or electric shock.
- This appliance is intended to be used in household and similar applications such as
 - staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments;
 - farm houses and by clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments;
 - bed and breakfast type environments;
 - catering and similar non-retail applications.
-  **WARNING!** Any electrical components(plug, power cord, compressor and etc.) must be replaced by a certified service agent or qualified service personnel.
-  **WARNING!** The light bulb supplied with this appliance is a “special use lamp bulb” usable only with the appliance supplied. This “special use lamp” is not usable for domestic lighting.¹⁾

Installation

Important! For electrical connection carefully follow the instructions given in specific paragraphs.

- Unpack the appliance and check if there are damages on it. Do not connect the appliance if it is damaged. Report possible damages immediately to the place you bought it. In that case retain packing.
- It is advisable to wait at least four hours before connecting the appliance to allow the oil to flow back in the compressor.
- Adequate air circulation should be around the appliance, lacking this leads to overheating. To achieve sufficient ventilation follow the instructions relevant to installation.
- Wherever possible the spacers of the product should be against a wall to avoid touching or catching warm parts (compressor, condenser) to prevent possible burn.
- The appliance must not be located close to radiators or cookers.
- Make sure that the mains plug is accessible after the installation of the appliance.

Environment Protection

 This appliance does not contain gasses which could damage the ozone layer, in either its refrigerant circuit or insulation materials. The appliance shall not be discarded together with the urban refuse and rubbish. The insulation foam contains flammable gases: the appliance shall be disposed according to the appliance regulations to obtain from your local authorities. Avoid damaging the cooling unit, especially the heat exchanger. The materials used on this appliance marked by the symbol  are recyclable.

 The symbol on the product or on its packaging indicates that this product may not be treated as household waste. 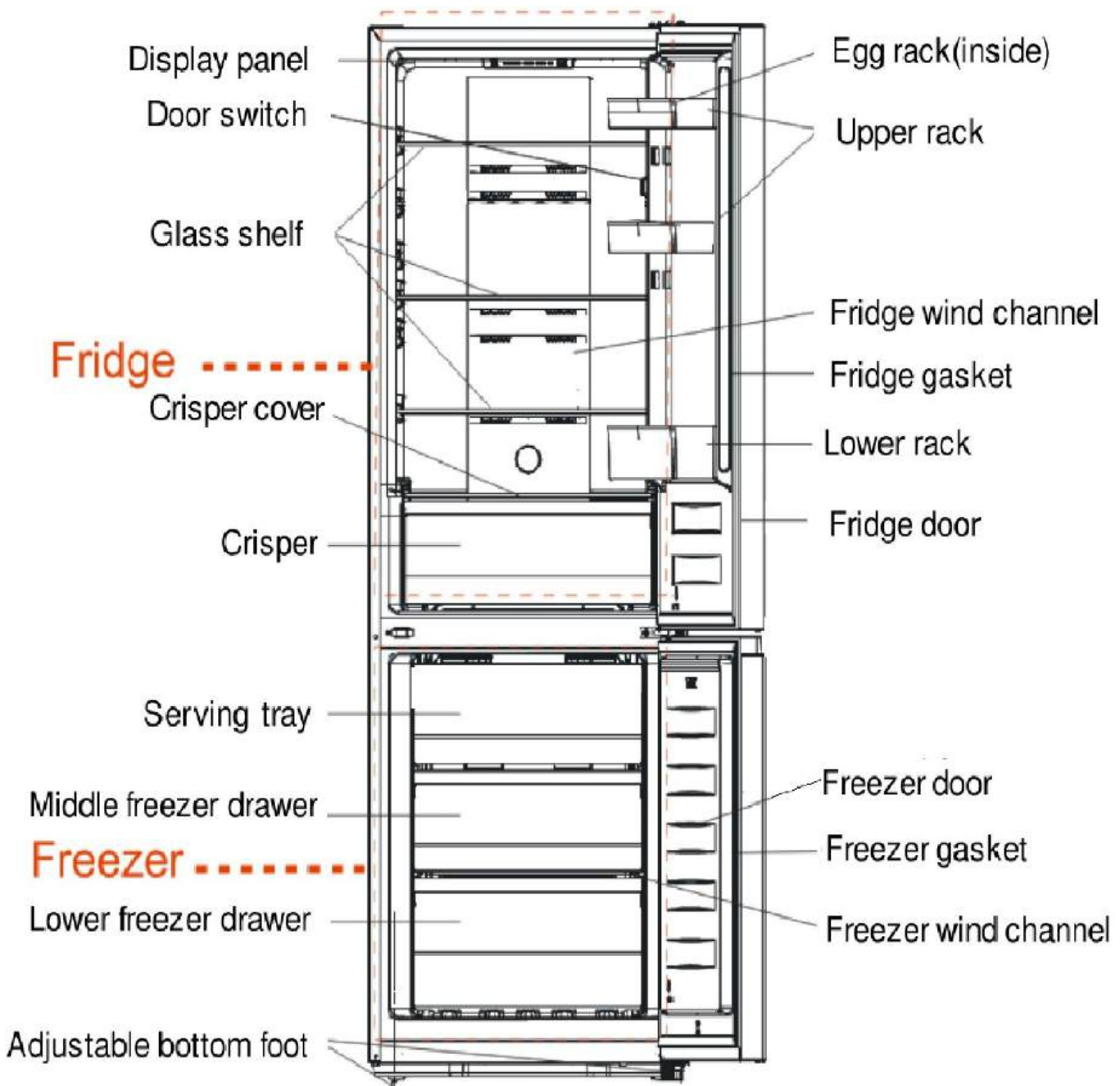

Note: Due to unceasing modification of our products, your refrigerator may be slightly different from this instruction manual, but its functions and using methods remain the same. To get more space in the freezer, you can remove drawers (except lower freezer drawer), ice tray.

Location

The appliance should be installed well away from sources of heat such as radiators, boilers, direct sunlight etc. Ensure that air can circulate freely around the back of the cabinet. To ensure best performance, if the appliance is positioned below an overhanging wall unit, the minimum distance between the top of the cabinet and the wall unit must be at least 100 mm. Ideally, however, the appliance should not be positioned below overhanging wall units. Accurate leveling is ensured by one or more adjustable feet at the base of the cabinet.

 **Warning!** It must be possible to disconnect the appliance from the mains power supply; the plug must therefore be easily accessible after installation.

Electrical connection

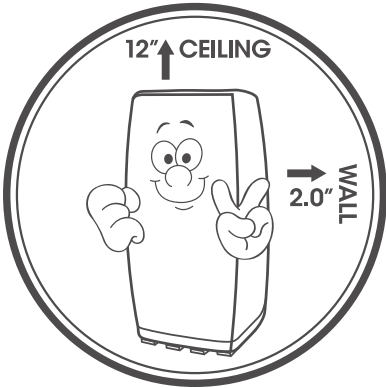
Before plugging in, ensure that the voltage and frequency shown on the rating plate correspond to your domestic power supply. The appliance must be earthed. The power supply cable plug is provided with a contact for this purpose. If the domestic power supply socket is not earthed, connect the appliance to a separate earth in compliance with current regulations, consulting a qualified electrician. The manufacturer declines all responsibility if the above safety precautions are not observed. This appliance complies with the E.E.C. Directives.

Start-up

1. Place refrigerator on a firm & flat surface; and away from direct sunlight & heat sources (like oven or stove).

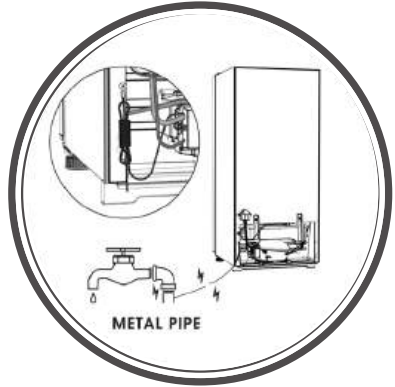


2. Leave at least 2 inches of space between ref and wall; and 12 inches of space between ref and ceiling or overhead cabinet.



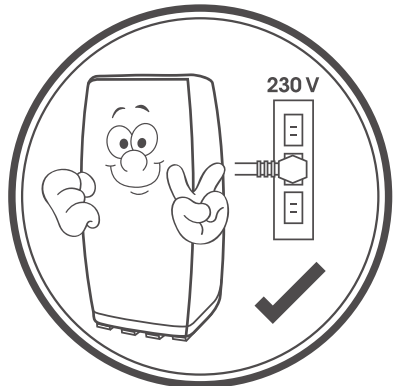
CAUTION or WARNING:
Install the unit in a well ventilated location.

3. For safety reason, it is advisable to ground the unit by connecting the ground wire provided at the back of the unit.
Do not connect the grounding wire to any gas pipes or phones lines.



4. Let the motor oil settle down for 6 hours before plugging-in the refrigerator.
5. Plug the refrigerator directly to a wall outlet (230V).

Do not use extension cord.



6. Allow the refrigerator to cool for 4 HOURS BEFORE LOADING FOOD & BEVERAGE ITEMS. Pre-cool with the temperature control knob set at: "4" settings.

User Interface

Operation and functions

Display panel

Use your appliance according to the following control regulations, your appliance has the corresponding functions as the control panels showed in the pictures below.



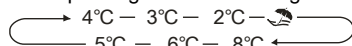
Controlling the temperature

We recommend that when you start your refrigerator for the first time, the temperature for the refrigerator is set to 4°C. If you want to change the temperature, follow the instructions below. **Caution!**

When you set a temperature, you set an average temperature for the whole refrigerator cabinet. Temperatures inside each compartment may vary from the temperature displayed on the panel, depending on how much food you store and where you place them. Ambient temperature may also affect the actual temperature inside the appliance.

1. Fridge

Press "°C" to set fridge temperature between 2°C and 8°C as needed, and display panel will display corresponding values according to the following sequence.



Note: When the "🌙" is lighted, the holiday mode is activated. Check the Holiday mode instruction.

2. Mode

You can select different modes according to your requirements by pressing the button "°C" on the display panel, and the corresponding icon will be illuminated.

Super Freeze(❄️)

Super Freeze will quickly lower the temperature within the freezer so food will freeze faster. This can lock in the vitamins and nutrients of fresh food and keep food fresh longer.

- You can press "°C" display panel inside door)for 3 sec to get into super freezer mode.
- When Super freeze Mode is selected, the light will be illuminated and the freezer temperature will be set at -24°C. • In case of the maximum amount of food to be frozen, please wait about 24h.
- Super freeze automatically switches off after about 52 hours and then the freezer temperature setting will revert back to the previous setting.

3. Holiday(🌙)

If you are going to be away for a long period of time, press "°C" you can activate this function.

When Holiday Mode is activated, the light will be illuminated. The freezer temperature will be set at -18°C and the fridge temperature will be set at 15°C.

Important! Do not store any food in the fridge during this time.

4. Switch(🔌)

You can switch on or switch off your appliance by press this button.

Press "🔌" 3 seconds, after a buzzer sound, the appliance will be turned off.

Press "🔌" 1 seconds, after a buzzer sound, the appliance will be turned on.

Troubleshooting

Common problem and checking

If you experience a problem with your appliance or are concerned that the appliance is not functioning correctly, you can carry out some easy checks before calling for service, please see below.

Warning! Don't try to repair the appliance yourself. If the problem persists after you have made the checks mentioned below, contact a qualified electrician, authorized service engineer or the shop where you purchased the product.

Problem	Possible cause & Solution
Appliance is not working correctly	Check whether the power cord is plugged into the power outlet properly.
	Check the fuse or circuit of your power supply, replace if necessary.
	It is normal that the freezer is not operating during the defrost cycle, or for a short time after the appliance is switched on to protect the compressor.
Odours from the compartments	The interior may need to be cleaned
	Some food, containers or wrapping cause odours.
Noise from the appliance	The sounds below are quite normal: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Compressor running noises. •Air movement noise from the small fan motor in the freezer compartment or other compartments. •Gurgling sound similar to water boiling. •Popping noise during automatic defrosting. •Clicking noise before the compressor starts.
	Other unusual noises are due to the reasons below and may need you to check and take action: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •The cabinet is not level. •The back of appliance touches the wall. •Bottles or containers fallen or rolling.
The motor runs continuously	It is normal to frequently hear the sound of the motor, it will need to run more when in following circumstances: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Temperature setting is colder than necessary •Large quantity of warm food has recently been stored within the appliance. •The temperature outside the appliance is too high. •Doors are kept open too long or too often. •After your installing the appliance or it has been switched off for a long time.

Troubleshooting

Common problem and checking

If you experience a problem with your appliance or are concerned that the appliance is not functioning correctly, you can carry out some easy checks before calling for service, please see below.

Warning! Don't try to repair the appliance yourself. If the problem persists after you have made the checks mentioned below, contact a qualified electrician, authorized service engineer or the shop where you purchased the product.

Problem	Possible cause & Solution
A layer of frost occurs in the compartment	Ensure food is placed within the appliance to allow sufficient ventilation. Ensure that door is fully closed. To remove the frost, please refer to cleaning care chapter.
Temperature inside is too warm	You may have left the doors open too long or too frequently; or the doors are kept open by some obstacle; or the appliance is located with insufficient clearance at the sides, back and top
Temperature inside is too cold	Increase the temperature by following the "Operation" chapter.
Doors can't be closed easily	Check whether the top of the refrigerator is tilted back by 10-15mm to allow the doors to self close, or if something inside is preventing the doors from closing.
Water drips on the floor	The water pan (located at the rear bottom of the cabinet) may not be properly leveled, or the draining spout (located underneath the top of the compressor depot) may not be properly positioned to direct water into this pan, or the water spout is blocked. You may need to pull the refrigerator away from the wall to check the pan and spout.
The light is not working	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •The LED light may be damaged. Refer to replace lights in cleaning and care chapter.
Water dispenser is not functioning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Is the water storage box installed accurately? Make sure there is enough water in the water storage box. •Is water line broke or bent? Make sure the water line is unblocked and clear of any obstruction. •Is the water storage box frozen for the refrigerator temperature is too low? Try selecting a warmer setting on the display panel.

1. COVERAGE OF WARRANTY

The Condura No Frost Inverter Warranty is applied to Refrigerators used for household purposes only.

2. WARRANTY PERIOD (from the date of original purchase)

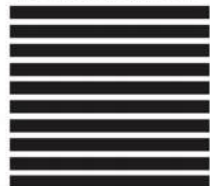
